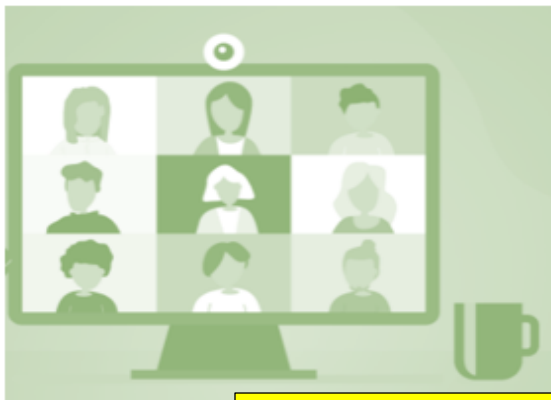

Father Paul Charbonneau
